Learning objectives of this workshop:

This workshop aims to help the participant to be able to:

- (1) Carry out systematic literature search, identify research gaps on the chosen research topic,
- (2) Organize and compose a scientific paper: title, abstract, keywords, introduction, materials and methods, results, discussions, conclusions, acknowledgements, references, figures, tables, graphical abstract, research highlights, etc.
- (3) Analyze and write a systematic, error-free scientific article,
- (4) Critically provide technical, scientific and non-scientific comments on others works, and
- (5) Facilitate adequate oral discussion(s) with other researchers.
